



## About Midtown Summer Programs

Fourth through Eighth grade students experience several weeks of hands-on academics, competitive sports, field trips, character education, and fun. Students attend daily classes in math, science, reading, and language. Sports foster a character-based and competitive learning environment.

Freshmen prepare for high school and beyond during three-week modules that intensively strengthen math, reading, public speaking, critical thinking, and teamwork skills within the context of the Business or Law professions.

Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors engage in apprenticeships. Apprentices strengthen academic, critical thinking, and teamwork skills within the context of the Visual Media, Architecture, Business, Computer Science, or Engineering professions.



## About Midtown Center

Midtown Center is a supplementary educational program serving 4th-12th grade boys from low income families in the city of Chicago. Since 1965 Midtown has provided academic enrichment, character education, individual attention, and extra-curricular activities for students, and parenting classes and discussions for parents.

Midtown Center is operated by Midtown Educational Foundation (MEF), a non-profit organization. MEF's programs are inspired by Opus Dei and the social teachings of the Catholic Church, and embrace students regardless of their religious, racial, ethnic, or familial status.

## Be A Midtown Advisor

Midtown seeks seventeen mature college men to serve as advisors and role models to over four hundred 4th-12th grade boys during Summer 2020. Advisors must have demonstrated academic achievement and leadership ability. Previous experience working with young people is desired. Advisors should be motivated to serve as effective role models and to form genuine friendships with their students and fellow advisors.

Each advisor coaches 15-24 boys on character growth. Through regular individual meetings, advisors work with each boy to develop and follow through on practical goals and resolutions pertaining to virtue, work ethic, a spirit of service, and friendship.

Advisors live together in a family style arrangement under the direction of a Head Advisor. Daily life includes working with Midtown students an average of six hours a day, meals together, get-togethers, sports, meetings, excursions, and cultural activities. Daily Mass and other times of prayer are also available.

The Christian orientation of the Summer Advisor Program is entrusted to Opus Dei, a personal Prelature of the Catholic Church ([www.opusdei.org](http://www.opusdei.org)).
