## ABOUT MIDTOWN SUMMER PROGRAMS

During normal summers, four hundred 4th-12th grade boys experience several weeks of hands-on academics, competitive sports, field trips, character education, and fun. Students attend daily classes in subjects like math, science, reading, and language. Sports foster a character-based and competitive learning environment. During a remote programming summer, advisors continue to live and work on site. From home, students attend hands-on online activities designed to be engaging and fun while sharpening math, English, and science skills. Advisors mentor their students and collaborate with parents remotely.
