service

At the core of the summer advisor program is service to others. Throughout the seven weeks, advisors are challenged to dedicate their energies to serve their team of inner-city boys and also their fellow advisors. The program is designed to help advisors grow in their ability to serve others and to make service to others a defining motivation for their life.



professionalism

A central goal of the program is preparing advisors for the rigors and responsibilities of professional life. The demands of the role challenge advisors to refine their initiative, accountability, and ingenuity, among other qualities of a good professional. In addition, the advising program features numerous exemplary professionals as guest speakers and opportunities for professional mentoring.



friendship

The summer program is an occasion for each advisor to significantly deepen his capacity for friendship. In addition to the daily advising component, advisors live together in a family-style residence, forming an essential and equally important opportunity for growth in fraternity and the virtue of friendship. The family life of the advisors includes daily get-togethers and discussions, weekend excursions, and visits to sites of cultural significance in Chicago.
